*Kansas City, Missouri, USA* - MidAmeriCon II is pleased to announce that Adult Day and Weekend Admissions are now on sale, alongside the existing categories of Attending and Supporting Membership.

All categories of Membership and Admission will remain available for online purchase until Friday, August 5, 2016. New purchases will then be available in person at the convention from Wednesday, 17 August.

Full Membership Rates (five day attendance plus publications and Hugo Award / Site Selection voting rights for Adults and Young Adult Members) are as follows:

- Adults \$210 (rising to \$240 on the door)
- Young Adult (age 16-25) and Military \$100 (rising to \$120 on the door)
- Child (age 6-15) \$60

Adult Day Admission Rates apply for each day of the convention, as follows. Day Admissions provide access to all convention programming, exhibits and events, but do not include printed publications or voting rights.

- \$70 per day for the peak convention days of Thursday, 18 August through Saturday, 20 August
- \$40 per day for Wednesday, 17 August, and Sunday, 21 August.

Adults can alternatively buy a three-day Weekend Admission covering Friday, Saturday and Sunday for a reduced rate of \$150.

Military, Young Adult, and Child Day Admissions will be available for purchase on the door only. Pricing for these groups will be announced separately in the coming weeks.

Daily highlights of the convention will include the 1941 Retro Hugo Award presentation and swing dance on Thursday, 18 August; the Masquerade on Friday, 19 August; and the 2016 Hugo Awards Ceremony on Saturday, 20 August.
